1. Ingredient name

Felodipine

2. What this medication is used for

(Hypotensive)

Treats hypertension and angina pectoris by expanding the coronary arteries and peripheral blood vessels.

3. How to take this medication

If the medication is in slow-release tablets, do not chew or crush them. Swallow with water.

May cause dizziness and vertigo. Move slowly when rising from a seated or lying position.

May cause swelling of the hands legs and feet at the beginning of the treatment. Consult your doctor if severe.

May cause temporary flushing by vasodilation of the vessels. Inform your doctor or pharmacist if the symptom continues.

In rare cases you may have gum diseases such as swollen gums. Immediately inform your doctor or pharmacist if you experience such symptoms and keep your mouth clean.
