### 1. Ingredient name

Metformin

### 2. What this medication is used for

(Antidiabetic agent)

Treats type II diabetes.

### 3. How to take this medication

Take with or right after meals.

May cause gastrointestinal disorders such as diarrhea, constipation, vomiting, inappetence, and indigestion.

If you experience any symptoms of hypoglycemia such as sudden hunger, vertigo, or shivering, eat a piece of candy, drink some fruit juice, etc.

In rare cases, you may have extreme fatigue, muscular pain, breathlessness, abdominal pain, hypothermia, or the symptoms of hypotension. If you experience these symptoms, stop taking the drug and immediately inform your doctor or pharmacist.

See your doctor regularly. If you plan to undergo surgeries or tests, inform your doctor that you are taking this medication.
