1. Ingredient name

Pranlukast

2. What this medication is used for

(Allergic disease treatment)

Used to treat bronchial asthma and allergic coryza.

3. How to take this medication

Take twice a day after breakfast and dinner.

May cause gastrointestinal disorders such as indigestion, abdominal distension, diarrhea, and nausea.

May cause headache, drowsiness, and dizziness.

If you have asthma, take this medication daily even if you experience no symptoms.

Do not suddenly stop taking the drug or modify drug intake even if you find the efficacy of the drug unsatisfactory. Consult your doctor or pharmacist first.
