

Medication Information for English Speakers

1. Ingredient name

Ranitidine

2. What this medication is used for

(Anti-peptic ulcer agent)

Treats gastrointestinal tract disorders by reducing gastric acid secretion.

3. How to take this medication

May cause dizziness and drowsiness. Avoid driving a car or operating machinery.

Avoid drinking coffee and alcohol, smoking, and taking analgesic/anti-inflammatory agents, as they may increase gastric acid secretion.

Sucralfate inhibits the absorption of this medication. Allow at least a two hour interval between them.

Not taking the medication as directed may lead to recurrence. Take the medication as directed.
